David Barnett being proven before Robert Cook Esq^r by
the oath of Wm P. Col was presented and proved this <sup>27th July 1807
This Indenture made this 27th day of May One thousand eight-
hundred between John M^r May of the State of North Carolina
and Persons County of the one part and David Barnett
of the State of S^t Carolina and Greenville County of the
Other part witnesseth that the said John M^r May for
the consideration of the sum of One hundred pounds
to him in hand paid by the said David Barnett the
Receipt whereof is here by acknowledged and the said
John May granted bargained and sold unto the said
David Barnett a certain tract or parcel of Land
containing three hundred acres more or less lying in the
County of Greenville on the North Fork of Enoree
being part of a tract of Land granted to Mary Russel
a part of a tract of land granted to Charles Tinkersby,
and hath such shapes forms and marks as the untraversed
beginning at Enoree River on Nelson's Corner thence to
a post oak on Land's line thence across the south fork
of said River a black oak thence to a black oak thence</sup>
