129 The following deed of Conveyance from John Cappell to  
John Hollon being proven before Thomas Edwards  
Esq & by the oath of Henry Chambliss was presented  
and recorded this 27<sup>th</sup> day of Feb'y 1801 —

This Indenture made this the Twentyseventh day of  
December in the year of our Lord One thousand seven  
hundred and nine ty nine between John Champion  
of the County of Greenville & State of Carolina on  
the one part & John Hollon of the County and State aforesaid  
of the other part witnesseth that the said John  
Cappell for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty  
three pounds Sterling money to him in hand paid by the  
said John Hollon the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-  
edged he the said John Campbell hath bargain and  
sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell  
unto the said John Hollon a certain tract of land  
lying and being in Greenville County on the waters  
Brushy Creek containing Two hundred acres of land  
more or less to bring apart of a tract of land
