and State of Carolina of the one part and Martin
Ayres of the state & County aforesaid of the other
part witnesseth that the said Gibson Sutherland
for and Consideration of the sum of Forty Dollars
to him in hand paid by the said Martin Ayres the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the 5th
Gibson Sutherland hath bargained and sold and by
these presents doth bargain and sell to the said
Martin Ayres his heirs and assigns forever a certain
tract or parcel of land containing One hundred and
Fifty acres more or less situated in Greenville District on
branches of Enoree river and bounded as follows beginning
on a black Oak corner and running thence $1^{\circ} 75' W$
 $82^{\circ} 56'$ to a stake corner then running with
Whortons $82^{\circ} 38' 37''$ to a post oak corner thence
running with Whortons line as far as the last
Kilm Branch thence up the branch to the head
thence to a post oak corner on Acreham Elleg's
land thence $170^{\circ} E$ 22' to a pine thence $80^{\circ} 40' E$ 26'
10' to a red oak thence $1^{\circ} 40' W$ 52' 3" to a pine from
thence to the beginning which said tract of land
of One hundred and fifty acres more or less with all
and every of its appurtenances the said Gibson
Sutherland doth from him self and his heirs and
from any other person or persons what so ever will
warrant & forever defend to said Martin Ayres
