The following deed of conveyance from Edwin Smith to Stephen
Butterworth being proven before William Hall Esqr. by the oath of
Stephen Clement was presented and recorded this 5th March 1801
This indenture made this eighteenth day of December
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and
ninety seven and in the twenty first year of American
Independance. Between Edward Smith of the County
of Pendleton and State of Carolina of the one part and
Stephen Butterworth of the County of Greenville &
State above mentioned of the other part. Witnesseth
that the said Edwin Smith for and in consideration
of the sum of Eighty pounds Sterling money of Sth Caro-
lina to him in hand paid at or before the sealing and
delivery of these presents by Stephen Butterworth the
receipt is hereby acknowledged I have bargained sold
and delivered and by these presents do bargain sell &
Deliver to him the said Stephen Butterworth a certain
tract or parcel of land by Estimation three hundred
and forty acres be the same more or less its being a part
of Two surveys lying and being on the north side of
