

The following deed of conveyance from Eledge & Elish Millers  
to James Abercrombie being proven before H Cobb Esq<sup>r</sup>  
by the oath of William Ross was presented and recorded this  
5<sup>th</sup> day of March 1801

The State of South Carolina, Greenville County  
Know all men by these presents that we Eledge and  
Elish Miller of the State of South Carolina and County  
of Greenville for and in consideration of the sum of  
one hundred and fifty Dollars to me paid by James —  
— Abercrombie of the State after said and County of  
Lawrence have granted bargained sold and released  
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release  
unto the said Jas Abercrombie all that or part of  
Land containing one hundred and fifty acres of  
Land more or less beginning on a pine tree running
