E, to a red oak thence S 40 E, 3/4 chain to a post oak
and from thence to the beginning corner containing
one hundred acres more or less being granted by a
patent to Robert Prince bearing date the sixth
day of February One thousand seven hundred and
eighty six and conveyed first from Robert Prince
to said Addams Together with all and singular
the rights manors and hereditaments and appurtenances
the said premises belonging in or in any wise
appertaining to have and to hold all and singular
