

176 The following deed of conveyance from James Abernombre to Thomas Williams being proven before Hudson Bury Esq^r by the oath of Warren Maysy was presented and recorded this 12th March 1801

State of Carolina Greenville County

Know all men by these presents that James Abernombre of the county and state aforesaid do in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty silver dollars to me paid by Thomas Williamson Esq^r of the State aforesaid and county of Laurens have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas Williamson all that tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and fifty acres land Excepting one acre including a spring on a branch above the plantation the above mentioned land being more or less Beginning on a pine 37 thence running on Ben^{ts} Brawers land S 70 W 30-50 to a R. C. 37 thence N 60-170 on Ben^{ts} Brawers land S 70 W 43 on Warren Maysy land to a stake 37 thence N 5 E on W^{ms} J^{rs} land 17-60 to a R. C. 37 thence N 68 E 57-50 on J^{rs} land to a stake thence S 36 W 31 to a ridge of thence S 55 E 34 on J^{rs} land to the Beginning corner.
