

176 The following deed of conveyance from James Abercrombie to
Thomas Williamson proven before Hudson Berry Esq^r by
the death of Warren Mayes was presented and recorded this
12th March 1801

State of Carolina Greenville County
Know all men by these presents that James Aber-
crombie of the county and state aforesaid do in con-
sideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty silver
Dollars to me paid by Thomas Williamson Esq^r
of the State aforesaid and county of Laurens have
granted bargained sold and released and by these
presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the
said Thomas Williamson all that tract or parcel
of land containing One hundred and fifty acres land
Excepting One acre including a spring on a branch
above the plantation the above mentioned land
being more or less Beginning on a pine 3^f thence
running on Ben^r a Bawars land S 70 W 30-50 to
a G. Q. 3^f thence N 60-10^r on 2^d B. Bawars
land S 1^r thence N 70 W 43^r on Warren Mayes
Land to a stake 3^f thence N 5^r E on Wnd G^r land
17-60 to a G. Q. 3^f thence N 88 E 5^r-50 on 2^d
Ags land to a stake thence S 36 W 31 to a rock
3^f thence S 55 E 34 on 2^d G^r land to the
Beginning corner including One hundred and
fifty acres of land Excepting the One acre aforesaid
one above to be taken of the same being more or
