The following deed of conveyance from Henry Linderman to Harmon Shoemaker being proven before John Burns Esq^r by the oath of Peter Linderman was presented and recorded this 13th day of March 1801

This Indenture made the 7th day of June one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight between Henry Linderman of the State of Carolina and county of Greenville of the one part and Harmon Shoemaker of the State and county aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said Henry Shoemaker Linderman for and in consideration of the sum of sixty pounds sterling to him in hand paid by the said Harmon Shoemaker at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is here by acknowledged by the said Henry Linderman hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain & sell and confirm unto the said Harmon Shoemaker his Heirs and assigns for ever all that parts or tract of land being the plantation the said Henry Linderman now lives on situate in ninety six Old District and county of Greenville on a small branch of red river known by the name of the Spring branch containing one hundred and twenty five acres more or less being Originally granted to John Pile Sr^t by his Excellency William Moultrie governor on the eighth day of June A D 1788 and conveyed to his son John Pile Jun^r on the 23rd October 1788 reference being had to the secretaries office for the Original grant and to the Original grant and to the Clerks Office of the county
