

214 The following Deed of Conveyance from Jepse Suggs to  
Dudly Howel being proven before David Goodlett Esquire  
by the oath of John Watson was presented and recorded  
this 10<sup>th</sup> day of June 1807

This Indenture made this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of December one thousand  
and seven hundred and ninety nine, and of the Independen-  
ce of the United States of America the twenty third  
Between Jepse Suggs of the state of Carolina &  
County of Greenville of the One part & Dudly Howel  
of the County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth  
for and in consideration of the sum of thirty five pounds  
Sterling lawful money of said State in hand paid by  
Dudly Howel hath bargained and sold & by these  
presents doth bargain sell and make over unto Dudly  
Howel a certain plantation or tract of land lying  
in Greenville County on the head branches of Rudy  
River such land creek which Jepse Suggs now livis on it,  
hath such boundaries where as to beginning on Black  
Jack corner running thence N 80 E 13 ch to a conditional  
Spanish Oak corner thence W 45 E 13 ch to a slate corner  
thence S 75 W 15 ch to a post oak corner thence N 72 W  
18 to a black oak corner thence N 58 E 13 1/4 to Plum corner  
thence N 72 W 10 ch to a slate corner thence S 65 W to a  
conditional Black Jack corner thence to a conditional  
Black Jack corner laid worth the line thence S 68 - 8 to a  
post oak corner thence S 70 E 12 1/2 to a slate corner  
from thence to the beginning it being a part of a tract  
of land containing eight hundred & forty acres granted  
unto Richabald Fowler from under the hand of his  
Excellency William Moultrie Esquire bearing date the  
fourth day of February one thousand seven hundred & ninety three
