The following deed of Conveyance from James Harrison ²²⁴ to Tho^s
Senkins being proven before John M. Elroy Esq^r by the oath Micajah
Senkins was presented and recorded this 30th day of June 1801
State of S. Carolina, — Know all men by these presents that
I James Harrison of Granville District and state aforesaid for
and in consideration of five hundred Dollars to me paid by
Thomas Jenkins of said state and District have granted
bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant
bargain sell and release unto him the said Thomas Jenkins
all that tract of land wherein the said Jenkins now lives
containing six hundred and forty acres lying in Granville
District and on both sides of muddy river bounded north west
ward in part by the said James Harrison's land, and part
by lands granted to Micajah Jenkins, on the N.E. by Micajah
land, also seven Negroes Viz Dick, Sam, Anthony, & one Male,
Females, Bernnah, Cloe & Ester — Together with all &
singular the rights ^{belonging} members Appurtenances and appertinances
to the said premises or in any way incident or appertaining
to have and to hold, all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said Thomas Jenkins his Heirs and
assigns forever; and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs Executors
and administrators to warrant and defend all and
singular the said premises unto the said Thomas Jenkins
his heirs and assigns against myself, and my Heirs only and
not against any other persons or persons meaning only to
warrant against me & my Heirs lawfully claiming or
to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal
this fifteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
