State of S Carolina — Know all men by
these presents that Samuel Bowen of Granville
District and State aforesaid for and in consideration
of thirty five dollars to me in hand paid by ~~Mr.~~^u
~~Hays~~ of the State and District aforesaid have granted to
bargained sold and released and conveyed unto him the
~~Mr.~~^s Hays all that tract or parcel of land lying and
being in the District of Granville on the south side
of Clear Creek or S^r Tigar river beginning at a black oak
whereon Usserys line crosses the said Creek running
thence to a red oak corner thence up to Kellys line thence
along Kellys line to the Creek thence down the
Creek to the beginning containing seventy nine
acres more or less together with all and singular the
rights, members hereditaments and appurtenance
to the said premises belonging or in any wise in interest
or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular
the premises before mentioned unto the said ~~Mr.~~^s Hays
his heirs and assigns forever and do hereby
bind my self my heirs executors and administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the
said premises before mentioned unto the said ~~Mr.~~^s Hays
his heirs and assigns against my self and my heirs &
against all and every other person whomsoever hee fully
