Thomas Camp being proven before Hudson Perry Esq. by the  
oath of John Arnold was presented & recorded this 9<sup>th</sup> July 1801  
The State of S Carolina Know all men by these  
presents that Benjamin Arnold of Greenville County  
in the State aforesaid in consideration of fifty dollars  
to me in hand paid by Thomas Camp of the State and County  
aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by  
these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the  
said Thomas Camp a plantation or tract of land  
containing twenty five acres be the same more or less  
situate in Greenville County lying on horse Creek begin-  
ning on a post Oak 37 running thence S  $44^{\circ}$  W  
35 Chains on the said Benjamin Arnold's line to a  
sweet gum 37 near horse Creek thence down the said  
Creek 50 links from water mark on each side of said  
Creek reserved to the said Benjamin Arnold to the mouth  
of a branch thence up the meanders of said branch to  
Benjamin Arnold's line thence N 30 W to a stake 37 on  
Thomas Camp's line N 61 E 43 Chains on said Camp's line  
to a stake 37 thence S 29 E 10-40 to the beginning  
(being part of a tract of 119 acres of land originally granted  
to Samuel Farrance on the sixth day of April 1789 and pro-  
vided in the secretary's office in grant book I 113 page 234)
