to Peter Wolfe being proven before David Goddett Esq.
by the oath of Joseph Kelley was presented and recorded
this 27th day of August 1807

State of Carolina - Know all men by these presents
that Harmon Shoemaker of Greenville District in
the state aforesaid for an in consideration of the sum
of four Hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand have
granted bargained sold and released and by these
presents do grant bargain sell and deliver unto Peter
Wolfe of the District and State aforesaid a Plantation
or tract of land containing One hundred and seventy
acres more or less being situate in the District and state
aforesaid on the north side of ready river beginning on
said river on a spindle oak on a crooked stand then
N. 61° 14' E to post oak then S 40° 66' E to red oak then
S 84° 26' 56" E by summerlines line to post
oak S 45° W 36' 6" E to iron oak by James Edwards
line then S 47° W 32' E to a holly on said river then
down said river to the beginning together with all
and singular the rights members hereditaments and
appartenances to the said premises belonging or in
anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold
all and singular the said premises before mentioned
unto the said Peter Wolfe his heirs and assigns for
ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs & executors
and administrators to warrant and forever defend
all and singular the said premises before mentioned
unto the said Peter Wolfe his heirs and assigns
