

The following Deed of Conveyance from John Smoody to Mr
Walton being proven before Rubens Barnette Esq^r by
the oath of Justice Sam was present and recd this
5th day of October 1801

This Indenture made and concluded on the first
day of September one thousand eight hundred and one
in the twenty fifth year of American Independence between
Mr Walton of Rutherford County Carolina of the
one part and John Smoody of the State of Carolina Sta-
-ten District of the other part witnesseth that the
said John Smoody hath bargained sold made over and by
these presents doth bargain sell grant and deliver
unto Mr Walton for and in consideration of the sum of
forty pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the said
Mr Walton the Rec^r of which the said John Smoody
doth acknowledge grant by this deed a certain plan-
tation or tract of land granted unto said Smoody con-
taining two hundred and forty acres more or less situ-
ated in Greenville District and State of South Carolina
Muskeet a branch of Tygar River beginning on a
black oak running N 53° W 44.72 to a white oak thence
N 53° W 44.12 to a stone thence East 5° to a stone S 55° E
6 chains to the beginning corner he the said Smoody now con-
veys the same with the plantation and improvements
and all privileges there unto belonging unto the said Mr
Walton his Heirs and assigns forever to have and to hold
the same quiet and un molested clear of all rights of
dower or any other innumbrance whatsoever I do hereby
Oblige and ingage me my self my heirs Executors and
