State of South Carolina. Know all men by these Presents that I  
William Chandler Sen<sup>r</sup> of the State aforesaid and District of Greenville  
in Consideration of two hundred dollars to me paid by William Archer  
of Chester District and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold  
and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release  
unto the said William Archer all that part or parcel of Land  
being a part of a tract of Land lying and being in the aforesaid  
District of Greenville surveyed by Thomas Lewis on the 27<sup>th</sup> day  
of May 1794. begining on a stake near a White Oak, both <sup>marked</sup>  
3+ thence East 26 Chs. & 32 links to a Stake 3+ thence S 38 Chs. to a  
Stake 3x thence West 26 Chs. 32 links to a small Hickory 3x thence  
N. 38. Chs. to the begining White Oak, "Containing one hundred acres"  
together with all and singular the Rights Mem<sup>rs</sup> hereditaments &  
appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident  
or appertaining, to have and to hold all & singular the premises before  
mentioned unto the said William Archer his heirs & assigns for ever  
and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Exec<sup>rs</sup> & Adm<sup>rs</sup> to Warrant  
and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the s<sup>d</sup>  
William Archer his heirs and assigns against myself & my  
heirs and against person whomsoever lawfully claiming or  
or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand &  
Seal this first day of September one thousand eight hundred  
and one, and in the twenty sixth year of the Independence  
of the United States of America - Signed Sealed delivered and  
acknowledged in presence of - N<sup>b</sup>. the word "Containing one hundred acres"  
interlined before signed
