South Carolina. Know all men by these Presents that I Peter Larter of Greenville  
County in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of three hundred  
and fifty dollars to me paid by John Roe of the sd County have granted  
bargained Sold and Released and by these Presents do grant bargain  
sell & release unto the said John Roe a Plantation or Tract of Land  
in the said County on both sides of bush Creek including the planta-  
tion & saw mill & grist mill Containing Ninety acres of Land it being  
it being part of a tract 750 acres originally granted to Thomas Kevil  
on the 3<sup>d</sup> of March 1788 - and Recorded in the Land Office  
Grant book W W W H. page 311 and Conveyed by him to George  
Rupe again by s<sup>d</sup> Rupe to Peter Larter and by s<sup>d</sup> Larter now to  
s<sup>d</sup> Roe, begining on a pine corner 3+ m. om. thence on the original  
line S 30 E 25 chs across the creek to a Hickory corner, thence on  
a conditional line N 50 E 10 chs to a pine corner thence N 11 W.  
15 chs to a maple on the branch of the creek thence down the creek  
along the various courses to a White Oak corner on the N. side of  
the sd Creek thence west 14 chs to a Spanish Oak corner still  
continues on the same course through the tract, thence S 50 W.  
42 chs 50 links to the begining. Also fifty acres of one other tract of  
172 acres originally granted to Moses Lewis bearing date the 7<sup>th</sup>  
of Dec<sup>r</sup> 1795. Recorded in Grant book P. No 5. page 533, and  
by s<sup>d</sup> Moses Lewis Conveyed to Peter Larter, & now by s<sup>d</sup> Larter to  
the afores<sup>d</sup> John Roe, begining on a pine corner near Geo. Lewis'  
land runs N 50 E 91 chs 50 links to a Sassafras corner N 73 W. 42 chs 10  
50 links to the begining - together with all and singular the eight  
numbers hereditaments and appurtenances to the sd premises belonging  
or in any appertaining or incident thereto. to have and to hold all  
and singular the premises before mentioned unto the s<sup>d</sup> John Roe
