Know all men by these Presents that I Peter Sacks of Greenville County in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars to me paid by John Roe of the s^d County Have granted bargained sold and Released and by these Presents do grant bargain sell & Release unto the said John Roe a Plantation or Tract of Land in the said County on both sides of Bush Creek including the plantation & Saw Mill & Grist Mill containing ninety acres of Land it being part of a tract 750 acres originally granted to Thomas Keil on the 3^d of March 1788 - and recorded in the Secretaries office Grant book W W W W. page 311 - and Conveyed by him to George Ruffel & again by s^d Ruffel to Peter Sarter and ^{by} s^d Sarter now to s^d Roe, beginning on a pine corner 34 on om. thence on the original line S 30. E. 25 Chs across the creek to a Hickory corner, thence on a conditional line N. 50 E. 10 Chs to a pine corner thence N. W. W. 15 Chs to a maple on the branch of s^d Creek thence down the creek along the various courses to a White Oak corner on the N. side of the s^d Creek thence west 14 Chs to a Spanish Oak corner & still continues on the same course through the tract, thence S 50. W. 42 Chs 50 links to the beginning. Also fifty acres of one other tract of 172 acres originally granted to Moses Lewis bearing date the 7th of Dec^r 1795. & recorded in Grant book P. N. 3. page 533, and by s^d Moses Lewis conveyed to Peter Sarter, & now by s^d Sarter to the afores^d John Roe, beginning on a pine corner near Geo. Lewis' land & runs N 50 E 91 Chs 50 links to a Stake, thence N 73 W. 42 Chs to a Red Oak corner, thence on a conditional line through the original tract S 31 E. 28 Chs to a Post Oak corner thence S 15 W. 8 chains 50 links to a Stake corner ^{on} the original line, thence S 83 W. 7 Chs 50 links to the beginning - Together with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the s^d Premises belonging or in any appertaining or incident thereto. to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the s^d John Roe
