a pine thence S. 25° W. a Conditional line originally made to the
Beavardam Creek, thence down the L. Beaver dam to the beginning, in-
cluding four hundred acres more or less, and the s^d Ebenezer Rieu one
hundred & sixty five acres beginning on a pine thence S. 25° W. 73'
50' to a corner, thence N. 85° W. 16' to corner, thence N. 78° W. 14' so to
