 bargained sold & released, & by these Presents do grant bargain sell
 & release unto the said Thomas Woods all that parcel or tract of Land
 containing five hundred and Sixty five acres be the same more
 or less lying in the District of Greenville on the South side of the
 North fork of Saluda on Beaver dam Creek (that is to say) this^d Solomon
 Stone four hundred acres beginning on a White Oak on a^d Creek, thence
 E. 29. 50 to a Post oak, thence N. 45. E 48 to a Post Oak Benson's corner
 thence N. 32. W. 8 to a Post Oak Limes corner, thence N. 33. W. 75 Ch. to
 a pine thence S. 25 W. a Conditional line originally made to Bea-
 ver dam creek, thence down the s^d Beaver dam to the beginning; in-
 cluding four hundred acres more or less, and the s^d Ebenezer Rice one
 hundred & Sixty five acres beginning on a pine thence S. 25 W. 13
 50. to a Corner, thence N. 45 W. 16 to Corner, thence N. 78 W. 17, 50 to
 a Chestnut, thence S. 33. E. to a Corner, thence S. 20 W. 30 ch. to a Maple
