

Hence N. 70 E. to Red Oak Corner a Conditional Line made between Hutchens Foist and Clark Foist and from thence following the sd Conditional line to the begining together with all wood waters mines minerals hereditaments & appurtenances to the sd Lake belonging or appertaining to hold to the sd Solomon Foister his heirs and assigns for ever.

They yielding & paying such sums of money yearly as the Law may direct, and the sd Leonard Clayborne & him the instruments & specimens & every part thereof do warrant & for ever defend against himself & his heirs & assigns and against every other person or persons to the sd Solomon Foister his heirs or assigns for ever against all lawful Rights or Claims that shall or may appear hereafter In Witness whereof I have herein to set my hand & affixed my seal the day & year above written, sign'd

32 Know all men by these Presents that I Leonard Clayborne of the State of South Carolina Greenville District for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars well and truly paid before the delivering of these Presents to me by Solomon Foister, & by these Presents have bargained sold released and confirmed and by these Presents do ^{bargain} sell & release convey & confirm unto Solomon Foister all that part or parcel of Land lying and being in Greenville District on both sides of the south fork of Tyger River containing one hundred & thirty six acres "more or less" Surveyed for Randolph Casey the 14th day May 1787 situated in the District
