 veyed & confirmed, and by these presents doth grant convey and
 confirm unto s^d Thomas Howard part of a Tract of Land origi-
 nally granted to Uriah Conner Situate in Greenville
 District on the south side of Tiger River bounding on the Widow
 Langford Land and Peter Howard Land thence as the River
 runs to the Widow Langford's Land, containing fifty acres more
 or less, and now by these Presents by the s^d W. Few unto the s^d Tho. Howard
