


The State of South Carolina, Pendleton District, Know all men by these
 Presents that I Jacob Light Sen^r. of the State & district afores^t in con-
 sideration of the sum of Fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Jacob
 Light jun^r. all that tract Plantation or parcel of land situate lying
 and being in the District of Greenville & State afores^t on Saluda River
 bounded as follows beginning on a White Oak on S^t. River bank run-
 ing thence N. 45 E 7 ch. to Post O. thence N. 67 E. 23 ch. to Spanish O.
 thence N. 35 W. 24 ch. to Post O. thence N. 3 E. 34 ch. 50 links to Post O.
 thence S. 44 W. 5 ch. to White O. thence S. 17 W. 44 ch. 50 l. to black C. thence
 S. 50 W. 30 ch. to Stake on the River. Hence down the same to the beginning
 Containing One hundred and thirty six "acres more or less" granted to
 Jacob Light Sen^r. by his excellency Charles Pinckney the 5th day of
 June 1797. together with all and singular the lights members heredita-
 ments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise
 incident or appertaining to have and to hold all & singular the Pre-
 mises before mentioned unto the said Jacob Light jun^r. his heirs and
 assigns forever, & I do hereby bind myself my Heirs Exe. or & Adm^r to
 warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises
 unto the said Jacob Light jun^r. his heirs and assigns against myself
 my heirs & assigns and all other persons claiming by me my Heirs
 & assigns of any part or parcel thereto. Witness my hand & Seal this
 29 day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
