

The State of South Carolina, Penatton District, Know all men by these Presents that I Jacob Light Sen<sup>r</sup> of the State & district afores<sup>d</sup> in consideration of the sum of Fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Jacob Light Jun<sup>r</sup>: all that tract Plantation or parcel of land situate lying and being in the District of Greenville & State afores<sup>d</sup> on Saluda River bounded as follows beginning on a White Oak on S<sup>d</sup> River bank running thence N. 45 E. 7 Ch. to Post O. thence N. 67 E. 23 Ch. to Spanish O. thence N. 35 W. 24 Ch. to Post O. thence N. 3 E. 34 Ch. 50 links to Post O. thence S. 77 W. 5 Ch. to White O. thence S. 17 W. 44 C. 50 l. to black C. thence S. 50 W. 30 Ch. to Stake on the River thence down the same to the beginning, Containing One hundred and thirty six 'acres more or less' granted to Jacob Light Sen<sup>r</sup> by his excellency Charles Pinckney the 5<sup>th</sup> day of June 1797. together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all & singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Jacob Light Jun<sup>r</sup>: his heirs and assigns for ever, & I do hereby bind myself my heirs & assigns to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the s<sup>d</sup> premises unto the s<sup>d</sup> Jacob Light Jun<sup>r</sup>: his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs & assigns, and all other persons claiming by me my heirs & assigns any part or parcel thereof - Witness my hand & Seal this 29 day of August. in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & one Signed & Sealed & delivered in presence -
