 wise incident or appertaining. to have and to hold all & singular
 the premises before mentioned unto the 1st George Cox his heirs &
 assigns for ever. and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors
 & administrators to warrant and for ever defend all & singular the
 1st premises unto the 1st George Cox his heirs and assigns against
 myself and my heirs & against every person whomsoever lawfully
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my
 hand & seal this tenth day of December, One thousand Seven
 hundred and Ninety eight - Signed sealed & delivered in the
