


Tract of land on the East side of the beaver dam Creek where the s^r Hooker

 for ever, in witness whereof I have set my hand & seal this
 24th day of May 1801. & in the 25th year of the independency
 of the United States of America — Signed in

 twentieth day of October 1801 John Goodlett came before me
 & with on his oath, that he was present and did see Elias
 Carle sign and as his act and deed deliver the within
 deed of Conveyance to Thomas Hooker for the Use & purpose
 therein mentioned and that he did see James Garrison
 with himself subscribe their names as witnesses to the same
 sworn to and subscribed the day & date above written
 before me Hudson Berry J. C. John Goodlett
