 by these Presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said  
 James Sanders Guignard all that plantation or tract of Land  
 containing forty six acres situate in Pickney District  
 Spartanburgh County between the Middle & South fork of  
 Tyger River bounded east by Andrew Brown land originally  
 Surveyed for William Gorham January 1799. Also one  
 hundred Sixty Six acres situate on Reaborn Creek of  
 Reedy River bounded S.W. by James Alexander Land  
 S.E. by John Redden Land S.W. an old Survey originally  
 Surveyed for James Linn the 9<sup>th</sup> Nov. 1799. All said  
 Plantations or Parcels of Land are granted to me by his Exel-  
 lency Edward Rutledge Esq; Governor &c on the second  
 day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven  
 hundred & ninety nine together with all & singular  
 the Rights, Members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the said  
 premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining  
 to have & to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned  
 unto the said James Sanders Guignard his heirs & assigns forever,  
 And I do hereby bind my heirs Esq<sup>r</sup> & Adam<sup>r</sup> to warrant  
 & for ever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said  
 James S. Guignard, his heirs & assigns against myself and my  
 heirs &c lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any  
 part thereof - Witness my hand & Seal this tenth day of  
 March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
 & in the twenty fourth year of the Independence of the United  
 States of America - Signed, Sealed & Delivered in the
