Brasher of the District of Greenville in the State aforesaid in consid-  
eration of the sum of two hundred and ten dollars to me paid by John  
Jones of the District and State aforesaid have granted bargained  
and released and by these Presents do grant bargain sell & release  
unto the said John Jones one hundred acres of land more or  
less lying in Greenville District on Zachary branch, waters of  
the Gold in Cove, being part of a Tract of land originally granted  
to Francis Beemer the third day of April one thousand seven  
hundred & Eighty six, and signed by his excellency Wm  
Moultrie, the said one hundred acres of land more or less is  
laid out unto the said John Jones as follows, beginning on a  
Black Oak, from thence S 45 W 23 chains with the Original  
line to a post Oak, thence N 45 W 43, 50. to a Corner on a  
Black Oak on Joseph Lowells Corner thence S 45 E, 23 Ch.  
by a Conditional line between Sowards & Muggers to corner on  
Black Oak on o. line, & thence with a line of marked trees to  
the beginning Corner, including one hundred acres of land  
more or less - Together with all and singular the rights members  
hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises or belonging or
