David Cotton his heirs and assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and admors to warrant and for ever defend all & singular the said one hundred acres of land with the premises unto the s^d. David Cotton his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs & assigns & all and every other person or persons whatsoever. in witness whereof I do hereunto set my hand and seal this first day of October one thousand eight hundred and One - Signed Sealed and delivered in presence of us James Cotton, Hezekiah ^{his} Cockrum - James ^{his} Dyal ^{mark}

I Charles Greenville District, personally came James Cotton before me the Subscribing Justice, and made oath that he saw James Dyal sign the within deed of conveyance and deliver the same to David Cotton for the use within mentioned also that he saw Hezekiah Cockrum subscribe his name with himself as witness to the same. Witnesseth that the said John Butler for and in consideration of the sum 23 dollars and 98 Cents to me in hand paid by the said Horatio Griffin & G^o. at or before the Sealing & delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the s^d. John Butler hath granted bargained and sold, and by these presents doth Grant bargain sell and release & confirm unto the said Horatio Griffin & G^o. their heirs and assigns for ever, all that Tract of land that said John Butler now lies on, bounded by John Dacos land Drury Druggys land & Tho. Butlers land & Willis Butlers land, containing One hundred acres more or less. together with all and singular the appurtenances hereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, together with all the rights titles interest claim or demand of in & to every part thereof to have and to hold the said tract of land together, with all & singular the premises hereby granted bargained & sold or intended to be granted bargained & sold to the said Griffin and G^o. their heirs & assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the s^d. Horatio Griffin & G^o. their heirs & assigns for ever. Provided all ways and it is the intent & meaning of the Parties that if
