Have granted bargained & sold & by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto Robert Duncan all that Tract or parcel of Land wherein my son John Harrison Jun^r. formerly lived containing One hundred acres more or less, it being part of a Tract originally granted to Charles Benson by his Excellency Benjamin Gourard Esq^r. date the 15th Octo 1784. from him Conveyed to the above mentioned John Harrison which will more fully appear from the said Grant and deed Beginning on the E. side of Reedy River on a Maple on sd River, running thence Eastwardly a Conventional line to a Stake in the original line, thence along the original line to a post-Oak corner, thence along the original line to the said River to a Stake thence up the meanders of said River to the beginning. Containing one hundred acres more or less Together with all & singular the rights, members hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to the the S^r. Robert Duncan his heirs & assigns & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to give over warrant and defend the above mentioned premises as to the Robt. Duncan & his heirs for ever. against the claim of me or my heirs or any other person or persons whomever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. in Witness Whereof I have caused to set my hand & seal this sixth day of February 1802. in presence of B.
