448 State of South Carolina, I know all men by Presents that John Sloan of Greenville District in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to me paid by Adam Sloan of Spartanburgh District H.W.C. granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents Do grant bargain sell and Release unto the said Adam Sloan a Plantation or parcel of Land in the Dist. afores^d of Greenville on Greens Creek of South Pacolet River - Beginning at a pine thence West to a Stake, Gentry's Corner thence in a direct line line with Gentry's and my Cross fence to the Creek, thence up the Meanders of the Creek to a branch on the S^e side thence up the branch to a Red Oak, thence N. 70 E. 12 Ch. to a Hickory thence E. 26 Ch. to a Chestnut, thence N. 2 E. 31 Ch. to the beginning - Containing by estimation 73 acres or the same more or less, the same (being the lower end of a tract) Granted to William Lyncho by patent bearing date the 5th day of June 1786. and by Lynche conveyed to David Hall & by him to Royal Pace, thence to me, Also One other parcel of Land joining the same Beginning on a Red Oak Willey J. Browns line
