that I John Sloan of Greenville District in conse-
cration of the sum of four hundred dollars to me
paid by Adam Sloan of Spartanburgh District
HAVE granted bargained sold and released, and
by these presents Do grant bargain sell and
Release unto the said Adam Sloan a Plantation
or parcel of Land in the Dist. afores^d of Greenville
on Green's Creek of South Pacoltie River -
Beginning at a pine thence West to a Stake, Gentry's
Corner thence in a direct line line with Gentry's
and my Cess fence to the Creek, thence up the
Meanders of the Creek to a branch on the S. side
thence up the branch to a Red Oak, thence N.
70 E. 12 chl. loc hickory thence E. 26 chl. to a
Chesnut, thence N 2 E. 31 chl. to the beginning -
Containing by estimation 73 acres to the same
more or less, the same being the lower end of a tract
Granted to William Lynch by patent bearing date
the 5th day of June 1786. and by Lynch Conveyed
to David Hall & by him to Royal Pace, & him to me,
Also One other parcel of Land joining the same
Beginning on a Post Oak Millie J. Brown's line.
