


James Powell of Laurens County and State aforesaid for and
in Consideration of the sum of the sum of twelve pounds Sterling
to me paid by Amos M. Dade of Greenville County, & that
aforesaid have granted bargained and sold, and by their Pre-
sents Do grant bargain sell and Release All that part of
Land lying in Greenville County it being a part of a tract
granted to said James Powell for 871 acres beginning at
a Stake Elizabeth Matthis corner and running with her
line and curving to George Underwood thence bounded

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
