This Indenture made this ninth day of October in the year
Lord one thousand eight hundred and one between John
Lemons of the one part, and Jacob Reese of the other part,
Witnesseth that the said John Lemons doth for the
Consideration of One hundred dollars to him in hand
paid before the sealing & delivery of these Presents the
Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge that he
bargained and sold, and by these Presents doth grant
bargain and sell unto Jacob Reese his heirs & assigns
forever, a Certain Tract of Land containing one
Hundred Acre, be the same more or less being part
of a Tract of Land formerly belonging to John Watkins
Deceased lying in South Carolina in Greenville County
on the waters of Mountain Creek beginning at a hickory
& running North Course to a post Oak, thence running
East Course to a Stake, thence running North East Course
to a pine, thence running South East Course to a Stake, thence
running South Course to a White Oak, thence running a
South Course to a pine, thence running East by a conditional
line made and agreed upon by and between John Lemons
& Abel Punnington to a White Oak, thence running to the
beginning: To have and to hold the said Tract of Land
containing as aforesaid, together with all the appurte-
nances thereof whatsoever thence in any wise be-
longing to the said Premises, & singular all the houses
& building waters & water Courses, and I do hereby limit
warrant & forever defend the said tract of Land to the said
Jacob Reese his heirs and assigns forever from all
