Know all men by these presents that Richard Brasil of Greenville County in consideration of the sum of twenty pounds to me paid by Eakin Hamlin of the County aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Eakin Hamlin a plantation or Tract of Land lying and being in Greenville County on Greens Creek of S. Pacolitt River beginning at a poplar & runs thence N. 60 W. 18 Ch. to a Stake & thence N. 85 W. 16 Ch. & 50 links to a Chestnut, thence S 30 W 25 Ch. & 30 to a Stake 3x thence S 58 E. 30 Ch. to a Stake 3x, thence N. 32 E. 20. Ch. to a Red Oak 3x. thence a Straight Course to the beginning containing by estimation Eighty Acres be the same more or less, it being part of a Tract granted to Richard Brasil by patent bearing date July the 5th 1793. together with all and singular the Rights members here appurtenances & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining, to have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Eakin Hamlin his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Adm^{rs} to warrant and for ever defend all & singular
