

State of South Carolina. I know all men by their Presents
 that John Staten of Greenville County and State aforesaid
 for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and
 fifty dollars to me paid by Abner Norris of the State &
 County aforesaid have granted bargained & sold & released
 and by their Presents do bargain sell & release unto the
 said Abner Norris One hundred "acres" of Land more or
 less beginning with those lines, beginning at a Dogwood,
 running thence South 32 W 30 Chains to white Walnut
 thence to Saluda river, thence up the river to the Mouth
 of Oilcamp Creek, thence up the Creek to a black gum
 a Conditional line thence to Thomas Youngs line, thence
 to beginning for complement more or less. Together
 with all and singular the rights, numbers, hereditaments,
 and appurtenances unto the said land belonging or in any
 wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all &
 singular the premises before mentioned unto the said
