Know all men by these presents that I Moses Kelly
 of Greenville District and State of South Carolina
 for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred
 and fifty pounds sterling money to me in hand paid
 by Bridget Kelly of the District and State aforesaid
 at & before the execution of these Presents the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold
 and delivered, & by these Presents do bargain sell and
 deliver unto the said Bridget Kelly four negroes named
 July, Diner, Peter & Sarah also three head of horses
 twenty head of Cattle, & thirty head of hogs with four
 Leather Beds & their furniture & plantation
 tools that is now in Possession of the said Bridget Kelly
 to have and to hold the above bargained property
 unto the said Bridget Kelly her heirs Executors Admrs
 & assigns to the only proper use and behoof of her the
 said Bridget Kelly during her natural life. and
 I the said Moses Kelly for myself my heirs Executors
 & Admrs do hereby bargain property unto
 the said Bridget Kelly her heirs and assigns
 against all persons shall and will warrant &
