Know all men by these Presents, that we William Armstrong and Mary Armstrong his wife for & in consideration of the sum of seven hundred dollars to us in hand paid by Julius Hoof hath granted bargained sold and confirmed & released unto the said Julius Hoof all that "tract" of land situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina in the District of Greenville on the waters of the Golden Grove containing One hundred and twenty acres, be the same more or less, bounded on the West by the land of John Westfield, on the S. & S. East by the land of the Widower Tenant, East & N. East on the land of Israel Charles & James Seaborn -
