



80 State of South Carolina, I know all men by these Presents that I Isaac Couch of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars to me paid by John Adkins of the State and County aforesaid Have granted bargained sold and Released, and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the said John Adkins a Plantation Tract or parcel of land containing one hundred acres or the same more or less, Situate on the North side of the North fork of Saluda there and is bounded as follows (viz) beginning on the River on Isaac Mayfield's line, running thence with said line N. to a Chesnut, the So. thence E. to a post Oak, thence West to a willow Oak on the River, thence by the various Meanders of the river to the beginning. This being part of a Tract of three hundred acres granted unto Capt. Samuel Warren the fifth day of December One thousand Seven hundred and Eighty five and from him conveyed to Major John Ford, and from him conveyed to John Couch, and from him conveyed to aforesaid Isaac Couch. Together with all and singular the Rights and members hereditaments, appurtenances to the said Premises, belonging or in any wise Incident or appurtenant, to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Adkins, his heirs and assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the premises unto the said John Adkins, his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. State and District aforesaid in the Condition sum of One hundred and twenty dollars to me paid by the said Joseph Ayres, and I the said Charles Burns, Have granted, bargained sold and Released, and by these Presents do grant bargain sell & Release unto the said Joseph Ayres, all that Tract of land containing One hundred and fifty acres more or less, Situate lying and being on the Still house Branch of Reedy River, on the South side of Bushy Creek in Greenville District & State aforesaid, bounded N. W. by Perry's land to a Red Oak from thence E. by vacant land, to red Oak, from thence S. W. to Red Oak, from thence E.
