This Indenture made this thirteenth day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and One, between Aaron Kemp of South Carolina and District of Greenville of the one part and Reuben Redman of the same State and place of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Aaron Kemp for & in consideration of the sum of Five hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Reuben Redman the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Aaron Kemp hath bargained and sold, and by these Presents doth bargain & sell unto the said Reuben Redman a certain Tract or piece of land containing by estimation three hundred acres lying & being in Greenville District, on branches of Brush Creek it being a part of a tract of land originally granted to Paul Abner grant bearing date first January 1785. And also a part of a Tract of land originally granted to the said Aaron Kemp grant bearing date the 5th day of January 1795. Beginning on a Maple stem running S 30 W. 31. 62 to a post oak, thence N 30 E 31 to a branch called bog ba, thence up S. branch as meanders to W. W. Redmans line, thence along S. line to a conditionally line made Between Richard Champ & S. Kemp to the head of Ramers branch thence down S. branch to Ramers line, thence along S. line to a post corner in the field where S. Kemp now lives, thence a straight course to the creek on Stake thence down said Creek as it meanders to the Maple stone - Which S. Tract of land of three hundred acres be the same more or less with all and every of its appurtenances the S. Aaron Kemp doth from himself & his heirs & from all and every person & persons well warrant and for ever defend to S. Reuben Redman his heirs & assigns for ever.
