


This Indenture made this twenty first day of December in the year our Lord one thousand eight hundred and one, between John Morgan of the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina of the one part, and John Lawry of the other part. Witnesseth that the s^d. John Morgan for and in consideration of the sum of two Dollars to him in hand paid by the said John Lawry, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John Morgan hath bargained and sold, and by these Presents doth bargain and sell unto the said John Lawry a certain Tract of Land containing fifty Aers more or less, beginning Red Oak, thence old path to the creek thence down the Creek to S. Lovensides old line, thence along the said Lovensides, to a poplar, and from thence to the beginning Red oak being part of a Tract of Land laid out the said William Reese beginning with said Tract of Land fifty aers more or less, all & every of its appurtenances, the said John Morgan doth from themselves and their heirs & other person or persons will warrant and forever defend to the said John Lawry his heirs and assigns forever.
