

State of South Carolina. Know all men by these Presents that I
 Merrick Herrington of Greenville District and State aforesaid in con-
 sideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to me paid by
 Pleasant Casley of the District aforesaid have granted bargained
 and sold & released, and by these Presents do grant bargain sell &
 Release unto the said Pleasant Casley a Planter or parcel of
 Land lying and being in the District aforesaid on both sides of
 Morgans Creek waters of middle Sygne River, beginning at a pine
 and running thence West 42 chains to a poplar, thence S. 50 chains to
 a Red Oak thence E. 42 chs. to a red oak, thence to the beginning, containing
 two hundred and ten Acres be the same more or less, granted by a
 Patent bearing date the 21 day of June 1784. to William Wood & by
 him conveyed to Vincent Anderson & by him to John Robuck & by
 Robuck to John Whittton & by Whittton to the S. Herrington. Also
 One other Tract a parcel of land joining the above Beginning at
 a Red Oak Corner of the above Tract running thence N. 80 E. 28.
