



August the third Eighteen hundred and three. Know all men by these Presents that I Henry Beart of the State of South Carolina and Greenville District have bargained and sold and delivered unto Drury O. Howell of the District and State aforesaid the following article
 Nine hundred and thirty rabbit skins, three Cows & two calves, and two feather beds & furniture, and two Iron kettles, and twelve head of hogs and two hand hons, and two smoothing Irons, and broochery ware & Powder, & chest & Trunk and one table and two Chairs, & three bushels of Wheat, and four haters bows, and one pot and oven. this being for value received, as witness my hand and seal

Personally appear before me one of the Justices assigned to keep the peace Taulton Hall and after being duly sworn sayeth that he saw Henry Beart sign seal and deliver the within Bill of sale to Drury O. Howell for the within purposes mentioned. Sworn to and subscribed this first day of Sept. 1803. before me Philip Evans J.P. Taulton Hall

South Carolina Greenville District. Know all men by these Presents that Lewis Landreth of the State and District aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars to paid in hand the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these Presents do grant bargain and sell unto Thomas Springfield his heirs &c one certain Tract or parcel of land containing one hundred acres be the same more or less lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, it being the Tract or parcel of land that John Landreth sold to Lewis Landreth, and all the said Tract that lies by the south side of Inoce River, and bound by the lines, & marked Trees, waters and water courses mentioned in the deed given me by William Subb, contained as a hundred acres more or less.

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments to & land & premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to the said Thomas Springfield his heirs and assigns forever, and I do for my part Warrant and defend a good and lawful right to said land & premises against the claim of myself and my heirs and all other claims whatsoever claiming it or any part thereof. in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hands and seal this 18th day of September Eighteen hundred and Three signed sealed & delivered in the presence of us Lewis ^{his} Landreth
