 hand paid by Henry Hill of Greenville District and State aforesaid: have granted
 Bargained, Sold, and Released and by these presents do grant, Bargain, Sell, and release
 unto the said Henry Hill a plantation or tract of Land containing sixty two acres (Be the same
 more or less) Situate in Greenville District lying on the Branches of horse Creek waters
 of Sandy river. Beginning on a Post oak 9X on the old Indian line Running thence S 71° W.
 18 on said line to a red oak 9X thence N 40° W 30 on Perry Hollands line to an oak 9X
 on a Branch thence down the meanders of said Branch a N.E. Course about 24 Chains
 to the confluence with another or other small Branch thence a S.E. course up the meanders
 of said branch to the head; Near the Beginning corner thence on East Neighbors to the
 beginning (Being part of a tract of 996 acres of land originally granted to the said Samuel
 Nughbors) Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and
 appertinances to the said premises Belonging in anywise Incident or appertaining
 To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said
 Henry Hill his heirs and assigns forever. And I do here by bind my self my heirs Executors

 paid by Sylvanus Gardner of the State of North Carolina have granted, Bargained,
 Sold Released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, Sell and release unto the S.
 Sylvanus Gardner a plantation or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of
 Greenville, on the waters of middle Tyger river and Beaver dam creek, beginning at a
 white oak Slitum tree near a branch and running thence N 71° E. 5 1/2 chains to a
 white oak, thence N 50° W. 25 ch. to a white oak thence S. 73° W. 23 ch. to a
 small red oak, thence S. 35° W. 51 ch. to a small post oak & thence to the beginning
 containing ^{by} Estimation Four Hundred and fifty acres or the same more or less, the same
 being the East end. and part of a tract of land containing Tiffen Hundred and
 Forty two acres, granted by patent bearing date June 2nd 1788 unto Major
 Toffen, & by him conveyed to me, Together with all & singular the rights
 members hereditaments & appertinances to the said premises being or in any wise
 appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
