

The said grants it being laid out on the south side of ready river begining at one of the head branches of armstrongs creek down s<sup>d</sup> branch to where the original line comes down s<sup>d</sup> branch the original line to a spanish oak over thence the original line to a white oak thence North 25 degrees W. 22 br. & 25 links to a stake thence N. 6<sup>o</sup> E. 43 chains 95 links to a stake thence South 25 degrees E. 22 br. & 25 links thence to the begining to include one hundred and forty acres of land I the said John Billups do warrant and forever defend the above mentioned tract of land to the said John Harrison his heirs and assigns free & clear from me my heirs and from all and every person or persons whatever laying legal claim to the same in witness whereof I have here unto set my hand and seal the day and date above mentioned — Signed sealed & delivered in the presence of us

This Indenture Made this thirtieth day of April in the year of our Lord Christ Eighteen hundred between David Lovel of Greenville County & State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina of the one part and John Harrison of the same County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the s<sup>d</sup> David Lovel for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred sixty Dollars to him in hand paid by the s<sup>d</sup> Harrison before the Enacting & delivery of these doth hereby acknowledge for himself & his heirs hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto the s<sup>d</sup> John Harrison his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying & being in the County & State aforesaid on the waters of Armstrongs creek containing one hundred acres more or less being part of a tract of two hundred and 88 acres granted to David Brown bearing date fourth day of December one thousand four hundred eighty six and bounded as follows, begining on a red oak thence N. 15 D. 42. 50. to a gum station thence to a spanish oak over thence N. 50. D. E. 15' thence a conditional line by Detang thence the conditional to William Thiesen line thence Southern line to to the begining. To have & to hold the above sold land and premises withall and singular the franchises and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to have the said one, Harrison his heirs or assigns forever to have & to hold the same freely & enjoy the same
