

Originally granted to the ^{sd} Underwood by his Excellency Charles Pinckney Grant ^{by} ~~by~~ date the 5th day of November 1792. this ^{sd} tract of one hundred ^{& seventy} acres is bounded by lines as follows (Viz) beginning at a pine corner running thence N. 35 ch. to a post oak corner bounded by Wadsworths land, from thence E. 15 ch. to a pine corner, from thence S. 52 E. 47 to a post oak corner, from thence S. 24 W. 24 to a black Oak corner, from thence S. 2 E. 47 to a post oak corner, from thence S. 44 W. 1 N. 25. W. 8. 50 to a red oak corner, from thence N. 30 W. 25 to a st. corner bounded by Geo. Underwoods land from thence N. 61. W. 20, to the beginning. bound by Ratts Birdsongs land which ^{sd} tract of land of one hundred & seventy acres with all and every of its appertinences we the said George Underwood and Sarah Underwood doth from ourselves and our heirs and from all and every other person and persons will warrant and forever defend to the said Archer Fousler his heirs and Assigns forever, in witness whereof we the ^{sd} George Underwoods and Sarah Underwood hath hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals the day and year above written signed sealed and Delivered in presence of -

W. 235 feet to a stake thence N. 15 1/2 E. 140. feet to a stake thence S. 74 1/2. E. 235 feet thence S. 15 1/2 W. 140 feet to the beginning containing one acre to the same more or less agreeable to the chart of said village reference there unto had more fully and at large appear, Together with all and singular the rights, Members, hereditaments & appertinances to the premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining -
