granted to John Redmon by patent bearing date the twenty first day of January
one thousand seven hundred eighty five and being on a Creek called Durbin Creek
in the State afores^d Recorded in Secretary office in the Book 6666 Page 4915
Beginning on a maple on s^o Creek running thence N. 15 E. with s^o side line of
s^o tract then S. 75 E. 54 chains to stake on s^o line then S. 15 W. 54 chains to hickory
on s^o Creek then down the various courses of the Creek to the beginning supass to
contain one hundred acres more or less - Together with all and singular the
rights members hereditaments & appertinances to the s^o premises belonging or
in any wise incident or appertaining To have & to hold all and singular the
premises before mentioned unto Joel Reed his heirs & assigns forever & I do hereby
bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant & forever defend all
& singular the s^o premises unto Joel Reed his heirs and assigns against my
heirs & against every other Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim
the same or any part thereof - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
