W. 63. Ch. 50. To a pine corner thence N. 40. E. 60. Ch. to a pine corner thence S. 46. Ch. to a Spanish Oak Corner thence S. 35. E. 17. Ch. to a Stake corner thence S. 40. W. 30. to a Spanish Oak corner thence S. 30. E. 9. Ch. 50. links to a Spanish Oak corner thence S. 33. W. 50. Chains to the Beginning - it being Originally Granted to the saids Henry M. Woods as may appear by the original plat and grant of the same Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the saids Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the saids John Macbeth his heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and forever defende all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the saids John Macbeth his heirs & assigns against (myself)
