at the suit of Francis T. Walker to me directed, commanding

sum of two hundred and sixty nine dollars & 23/100 damages and costs
so seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said Beverly Dan-
iel certain piece parcel and tract of land containing one
hundred & sixty acres more or less situate and being in the district of Gre-
enville on a red oak tree on James Paynes land running East 14.75 chains
stake & thence N. 70. E. 20 chains to a pine stump in Joshua Ingolds
fence N. 14. E. 16 chains to a red oak tree & thence N. 14. E. 16 chains to a red oak tree
N. 41. W. 11 chains on Col. Walkers land to a Black Jack (dead) & from
42.0.68 chains to the beginning and where as the said premises with their ap-
pertinences since the seizure by me made, by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias
mentioned, have been exposed to sale at public vendue, and purchased by So-
lois of the district of Greenville & State aforesaid for the sum of one hundred
ninety two dollars being the highest sum that was bidder therefor; Now

fieri facias aforesaid, to me directed and delivered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the
Statute in such case made and provided, and for and in consideration of
