Know all men by these presents that I Rebeckah Burton of the District of Greenville in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of eight hundred and twenty two dollars to me in hand paid by Josiah Cobb of the District & State aforesaid have granted bargained, sold & released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell & release unto the said Josiah Cobb all that part of a plantation or tract of land lying in the district aforesd on the Beaver Dam Creek of Saluda River originally granted to John Blackwell on the 3rd March 1794 and conveyed by D. Blackwell to Shadrack Goodwin & from D. Goodwin to said R. Burton reference being thereto had will more fully appear. Beginning at a Stake 3x thence S.50W.33. to a chestnut 3x thence S.
